Arnold R. Toller, age 93, of Middletown, DE, passed away peacefully on Thursday, October 21, 2021.

Born in Portsmouth, Ohio, on January 8, 1928, he was a son of the late Robert M. Toller and Rushie (Conley) Case. Arnold proudly served in the United States Navy during World War II, where he served in the South Pacific aboard USS George Clymer. After his service, he owned and operated Atoll Buildings, Inc. and Case Erection in Newark for 50+ years. All who knew Arnold considered him a hard worker with a solid work ethic. He was member of Middletown VFW Post #3792.

In addition to his parents, Arnold was preceded in death by his siblings, Eugene Toller and Pauline Toller. He is survived by his companion for the past 35 years, Dallas P. Dean; children, Arnold R. Toller, Carolyn J. Bobinac, Robert E. Toller, Gary B. Toller, Jane McElhaney, and James Toller; canine companions, Princess and Deli; 14 grandchildren; and 13 great-grandchildren.
