



Charles David "Pops" Bullock

July 27, 1939 - February 19, 2020

It is with deep sorrow, but with much gratitude for a long and wonderful life, that Charles David Bullock, affectionately known as Pops, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, February 19, 2020 at the age of 80.

Born in Wilmington, DE on July 27, 1939, he was a son of the late Frank and Katherine (Poffenberger) Bullock. Pops honorably served in the US Army Reserves. He retired from Chrysler after many years of dedicated service. A passion for horse racing, Pops went on to work for Delaware Park where he enjoyed watching the races daily and was an exercise rider for thoroughbreds. He held a membership with Oriental Lodge #27 AF & AM.

Pop's flirty and fun-loving personality quickly made him a regular customer and a dear friend to many at Friendly's and McGlynns Pub where he would greet you with a warm hello, big smile, and occasionally a brazen insult.
