George Dallis Walker, Sr., age 91, of Middletown, DE, passed away peacefully, surrounded by his loving family on Monday, August 26, 2024. Born in Brack-ex, DE on October 8, 1932, he was a son of the late Alfred duPont Walker, Sr., and Martha Georgia (Little) Walker. George was a graduate of A.I.
