



Geraldine "Jere" Ebert

November 25, 1924 - October 26, 2021

Geraldine "Jere" Ebert, nee Staub, age 96, of Severna Park, MD, formerly of Newark, DE, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, October, 26, 2021.

Jere was a WWII war bride and a military wife for the first 25 years of her marriage, living in various states, including Hawaii and overseas in Morocco. During that time, she was a Red Cross and a Gray Lady volunteer. Retiring to a civilian life in 1968, the family settled in Newark, DE. Jere was a long-time member of St. Andrews Presbyterian Church (USA), Newark, DE and an active member of the church's women's Ruth Circle. She was also a long-time volunteer for Meals on Wheels as well as a local Adult Day Care Center. Jere was an avid reader, but nothing brought her more joy than spending time with her family. She was a loving sister, wife, mother, grandmother, great grandmother, great great grandmother and is loved and will be greatly missed.
