Richard Charles Nedohon, age 69, of Newark, DE, passed away on Wednesday, December 23, 2020 surrounded by his family.

Born on January 7, 1951 in Millville, NJ, he was the son of the late Peter and Zenina Nedohon. Richard was a graduate of St. Augustine Prep School in Richland, NJ and Seton Hall University in South Orange, NJ. He made his career in the pipes, valves, and fittings industry.
