Theodore Ted S. Winant, of Newark, DE, passed away on November 27, 2015.

Born in Talleyville on December 27, 1922, Ted was a son of the late Ralph Wesley and Margaret (Pennell) Brinton Winant. He proudly served as a US Navy medic during World War II. Following his discharge, Ted made his career as a central research technician at the DuPont Company Experimental Station in Wilmington, retiring after 43 years of dedicated service.

Active in his community, he was a member of the Martin Luther Foundation and the Delaware Rose Society. In his leisure time Ted enjoyed tending to his garden, raising beautiful roses; and cooking delicious meals for his family. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his siblings, Wesley and Elizabeth Winant. Ted is survived by his wife of 49 years, Dorothy A. (Trinks) Winant; sister, Mary Hall, of Wilmington; and many nieces and nephews.
